There is a collection for each of 9 domains of development and additional collections on topics like family engagement, supporting children who are dual language learners, building resilience, inclusion, etc. Also included in this resource collection is a handout on personas of children from infancy through third grade. Each child has a unique family configuration, likes, dislikes, strengths, and challenges. Some have disabilities, some are DLLs, etc. The personas are a great way to integrate consideration of individual children into an infant/toddler course.
